Siem Reap 02 Nights

Siem Reap is the 5th largest city in Cambodia with its 2,00,000 (200K) population, it is situated almost 320 km from Cambodian capital “Phnom Penh” and about 400 km from Bangkok, which is covered by Bus journey from Bangkok in approx 7 hours, It also has its own International Airport and you can fly from Bangkok to Siem Reap on a direct flight. Although Siem Reap is a famous tourist attraction because of Angkor Wat Temple but besides that historical value Siem Reap is also famous for its French Colonial architecture, low rise buildings and low cost pubs & clubs for Tourists.



Siem Reap is a town which is centuries old, enlighten in 15th century and till early 20th century, hardly called a town it was more like a village, after Angkor Wat Temple was Re-discovered in 1907 by French School of the Far East, as it was rapidly covered by forest around it. After rediscover Angkor Wat Temple regained its pilgrimage status and Siem Reap immediately became a famous destination for worshippers & tourists.

Angkor Wat Temple which is considered the largest Temple in the world and spread over 162 hector is almost 20 -30 minutes by Rickshaw (Three wheeler or bike cart) from down town (around 07 km). Angkor Wat was originally built as a Hindu Temple in 12th century to worship god Vishnu but later it was turned in a Buddhist temple by the government. Although it is very old, It is still so beautiful and glorious that you must not miss it while in Siem Reap, it considered so important that Cambodia carry this temple’s picture on National flag

On a visit to Siem Reap you feel like traveling back in time, low rise building, dusty roads, small road side café & Pubs, Motor cycle Rickshaws and traditional Cambodian food outlets, all get together and impressed you with its slow pace life style but with all dignity & prestige. This is one of the most ideal places in Far East if you are looking for a slow pace and relaxing vacation trip.

Tour starts at 09:00 am from your hotel lobby; first proceed to **Angkor Thom**; which means "the great city" in Khmer. The 12th-century royal Buddhist city is especially famed for its grand **Bayon Temple** with 54 towers each of them topped off with the four faces of Avalokiteshvara (Buddha of Compassion), continue to **visit Terrace of the Leper King**. Along the **Terrace of Elephants**, originally used as a viewing gallery for the king to preside over parades, performances and traditional sports, from here we go to experience nature running riot at the mysterious ruin of **Ta Prohm**, the original temple which was used to shoot famous *Hollywood* movie *Tomb Raider*;

Angkor Wat; Believed to be the world's largest religious building, this temple is the perfect fusion of symbolism and symmetry and a source of pride and strength to all Khmers. Built in the 12th century by King Suryavarman II, this is most famous temple at Angkor.

Tonlé Sap lake 🏠 After that depart for the largest permanent fresh-water lake in South East Asia which is connected to Tonle Sap river, originated from Great Mekong River, during boat ride in the Tonle Sap Lake we will see fishermen's "floating village" with floating school, shops & restaurants and floating police station. It is same as a big village floating in the waters, this "village" moves from place to place following water levels and current. Have lunch over big boat, which mostly contains sea food or vegetable fried rice



On the conclusion of this trip back to Siem Reap downtown, We will take you for foot massage, followed by walking to busy pub street where you can find many bars for cool drinks or shopping at famous Angkor Night Market. On the Conclusion of tour you will be drive back to Hotel, Spend evening on your own.

Phnom Penh 02 Nights

Phnom Penh is also known as "Krong Chaktomu", Phnom Penh is the largest & most populous city of Cambodia. Situated at the confluence of three rivers, the Bassac, the great Tonle Sap and the mighty Mekong which is 4350 km in length and cross 6 countries, Phnom Penh was once considered the 'Pearl of Asia'. Besides financial hub this city is also is the cultural, commercial and political centre of the country and is home to more than 1.5 million of Cambodia's population of over 14 million.



Founded in 1434, the city is noted for its beautiful and historical architecture and attractions. it was considered one of the loveliest French-built cities in Indochina. And it still has a number of surviving French colonial buildings scattered along the grand boulevards. Phnom Penh is slowly gaining high rise buildings, traffic lights, and Western style shopping malls, but overall remains one of the most undeveloped capitals in Asia. The capital city still maintains considerable charm with plenty to see of colonial era beside the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda, the National Museum, the Toul Sleng Genocide Museum, the Choeng Ek Killing Fields and Wat Phnom, there are several market places selling carvings, paintings, silk, silver, gems and even antiques. Recent political changes have triggered an economic boom, with new hotels, restaurants, bars and nightclubs springing up across the city.

Take this fantastic full day tour and discover Phnom Penh's historical sites and it's amazing scenery. Your tour will commence with the visit to **Royal Palace**; Build in 1866 the building with its Khmer roof dominates small yet beautiful skyline of Phnom Penh, Except for some compounds the rest of the building is open for public (appropriate dress code is must). Your next stop is the **Silver Pagoda** located in the southern part of the Royal Palace. The temple is also known as The Emerald Buddha Temple as it displays plenty of statues covered with diamonds, silver, emerald and gold. Continue your journey towards the northern part of the palace to the **National Museum**. It is a home to the world's finest collection of Khmer sculpture. The museum also contains displays of pottery and bronzes dating from 4th to 14th century articles to the most recent work.



You will be dropped to a restaurant during Lunch break. Your tour guide will then take you to the **Independence Monument**. The monument is one of the most striking landmark of the city, it marks the freedom of Cambodia from the French protectorate. Proceed to **Wat Phnom** (Hill Temple). Build in 1373 is your next stop. As the name suggest the temple is set on top of a 27m-high tree-covered knoll, the only hill in town. The journey continues to the **Central Market**, it is located in the heart of Phnom Penh downtown. The Khmer name of the market is Phsar Thmei. The Central Market was built in 1937 during the French colonial period, in Art Deco style, and is painted bright ochre. Shop on your own for souvenirs if you like to. You may then enjoy a **cyclo ride** along the riverside and study a great more deal about the city life.

Your tour ends with a one hour **sunset cruise** on **Mekong & Tonle Sap River**. Mekong is the largest river of the region with 4350 km length and starts from Tibet and then flows across Myanmar, Laos, Thailand, Cambodia, and Vietnam where it ends in South China Sea. Phnom Penh is the place where Mekong river meets Tonle Sap River and you can witness it during your boat ride included in tour

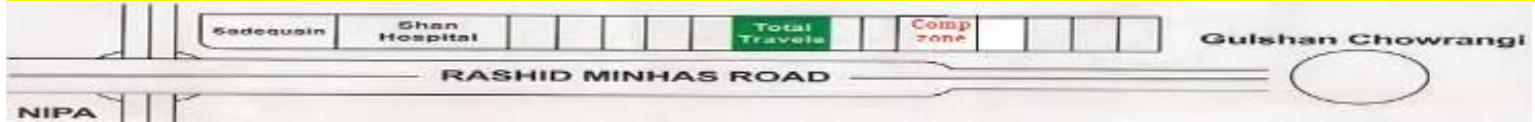
