


TURKEY 07 Nights 08 Days

Day 01

Upon arrival you will meet our representative/Chauffeur at arrival Hall, holding your name card, Please introduce yourself to him, He will drive you to your hotel in Sogut which is an approx. 4 hour drive 🚗 Upon arrival at your hotel check-in to your room.

SÖĞÜT

Sogut is a quaint, nondescript town of 14,000 people. A three-hour drive from Istanbul, navigating snaking roads cutting through the plateaus of sunflower, wheat, hop and lettuce fields, the town is fast gaining traction on Turkey's tourism map.



Earning popularity in the recent times this city was the birthplace of the Ottoman Empire. The founding Ottoman is buried here. The history of Turkey's predecessor state, the mighty Ottoman Empire, is deeply rooted in this humble rural setting. The central attraction in Sogut is the tomb of Ertugrul, where tourist numbers have swelled in the past few years. It was a normal grave until 1886 when it was turned into a decorated tomb. Outside the tomb are the graves of the Kayi leader's wife, Haleme Hatun, his second son, Savci Bey, and 19 honorary graves of Ertugrul Gazi's friends and close Alps (Kayi warriors). Nearby, marquees have set up selling Kayi merchandise: swords, leather armour, Bey caps, fur hats, flags, tribal attire, and gifts themed around *Dirilis: Ertugrul* for fans of the series.

BURSA

Bursa, the first capital of the Ottoman empire, lies on the lower slopes of Mount Uludağ with the city deriving its name from its founder King Prusias of Bithynia.

Known as "Green Bursa", the city is filled with gardens and parks and overlooks a verdant plain. It is situated at the centre of an important fruit-growing region. Bursa was, and still is, famous for its peaches, silk, towels and thermal springs. Make a point to try the locally invented İskender Kebab, a dish of bread, tomato sauce, strips of grilled meat, melted butter and yogurt! Candied chestnuts are another regional speciality.



It retains its Ottoman flavour and contains some of the outstanding examples of Ottoman architecture. Among its mosques, Ulu Mosque (1421) is a vast building with 20 domes, noted for the variety and fineness of its calligraphic ornamentation. On a terrace overlooking the city are the tombs of Osman I, founder of the Ottoman dynasty, and his son Orhan (Orkhan). A 15th-century theological school houses the city's archaeological museum. Bursa's several baths, fed by thermal springs famous in Roman times, include medieval structures that incorporated material from Justinian's imperial baths from the 6th century.

ISTANBUL

Istanbul, the only city joins Europe and Asia; located on both sides of the Bosphorus, uniting the East and the West on the terms of culture, art and religion. Halic Bay (Golden Horn) a horn-shaped bay located on the European side of Istanbul is one of the most beautiful natural harbors in the world.



It is Istanbul's endless offers of varieties that fascinate the visitors. The museums, churches, palaces, grand mosques, bazaars and sights of natural beauty seem innumerable. Reclining on the western shore of the Bosphorus at sunset contemplating the red evening light reflected in the windows of the opposite shore you may understand why so many centuries ago settlers chose to build on this remarkable site. The history of the city, which is known as the "Capital of the Empires", goes back to ancient times. The city was founded by the Megaras in A.D. 658 and was named Byzantium after their commander Byzas. It was developed very rapidly and turned into a large trade center, existed for hundreds of years as the capital of the Roman, Byzantine and Ottoman Empires.

Today it has become Turkey's most important tourism, trade and industrial city with a population over 13.5 million. The most beautiful historical works of Istanbul are at the historical peninsula inside the city walls between the Marmara Sea and the Golden Horn. One could visit Istanbul for the shopping alone. The Kapali Carsi, or Covered Grand Bazaar, in the old city is the logical place to start with more than 4,000 shops. Sultan AHmet which known for its Three glorious periods, Roman, Byzantine, and Ottoman, most of the famous and historical sights of Istanbul are located in this area. Topkopi museum A Must See will surprise you with the glimpse of history and culture treasure. It is formed in a 400 years old palace of Ottoman Kings. Istanbul a city where you see Asia & Europe penetrating.
