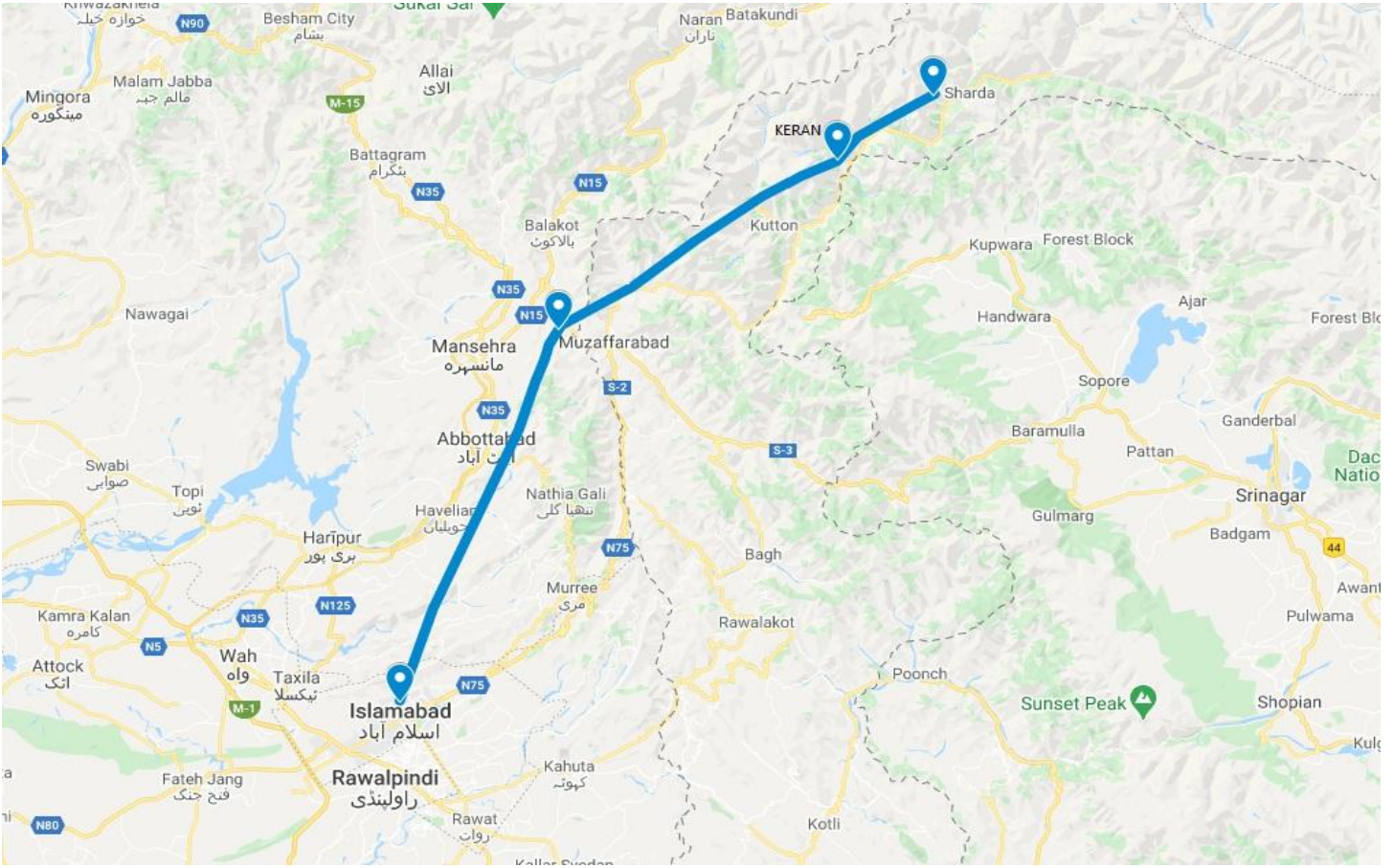

Daily Itinerary

- Day 1

Islamabad is the capital city of Pakistan, and is federally administered as part of the Islamabad Capital Territory. Islamabad is the ninth largest city in Pakistan, while the larger Islamabad–Rawalpindi metropolitan area is the country's fourth largest with a population of about 3.1 million.

Travel from Islamabad to Muzaffarabad via Murree Kohala point. Visit Al Jannat waterfall and Kashmir waterfall. Overnight stay in hotel.

- Day 2

Keran is a village and tourist resort in Neelum Valley, Azad Kashmir, Pakistan. It is located 93 kilometers from Muzaffarabad on the bank of Neelum River at the altitude of 1,524 meters.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Keran. Visit Dhani waterfall. Overnight stay in hotel.

- Day 3

Neelum Valley is situated to the North & North East of Muzaffarabad. Running parallel to the Kaghan Valley, it is separated from it by snow covered peaks, some over 4000 meters above sea level. Excellent scenic beauty, panoramic view, towering hills on both sides of the noisy Neelum River, flourishing green forests, streams, high altitude lakes and attractive surroundings make the valley a dream come true. The area is also ideal for mountain tourism.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Visit LOC and Upper Neelum valley. Proceed to Shardah. Overnight stay in hotel.

- Day 4

Shardah is located at a distance of 30 kilometers from Dawarian, it is a breath-taking green spot at an altitude of 1981 meters. Shardi and Nardi are the two mountain peaks overlooking the valley, named after legendary princesses Sharda & Narda. It has a captivating landscape with numerous springs and hill sides covered with thick forest. Over the right bank, opposite to Sharda.

Kel is 19 Kilometers away from Sharda. It is a small valley at the height of 2097 meters. This is another pleasing place in the Neelum Valley.

Arang Kel is a panoramic and break-taking village and is situated 9 kilometer from Kel followed by hiking track. Due to its scenic beauty a cable car is also offered pick and drop service from Kel to Arang Kel and mostly used by tourist. Arang Kel is renowned for tracking, hiking and adventure tourism.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Kel via jeep. From Kel cable car will be used to reach at Arang kel. After exploring beauty of Kel and Arang kel return back to Shardaah. Overnight stay in hotel.

● Day 5

Muzaffarabad is the capital and largest city of Azad Jammu and Kashmir, and the 60th largest in Pakistan. The city is located in Muzaffarabad district, near the confluence of the Jhelum and Neelum rivers.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Muzaffrabad. Overnight stay in hotel.

● Day 6

Pir Chinasi is a shrine and a tourist destination located about 30 kilometers east of Muzaffarabad, the capital city of Azad Kashmir administered by Pakistan. It is located on the top of hills at the height of 2,900 metres (9,500 ft). The mountain peak has gained large fame for its ziyarat of a famous saint, Sayed Hussain Shah Bukhari.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Visit Pir Chinasi. Proceed to Islamabad. Drop off at airport, bus terminal or train station.
