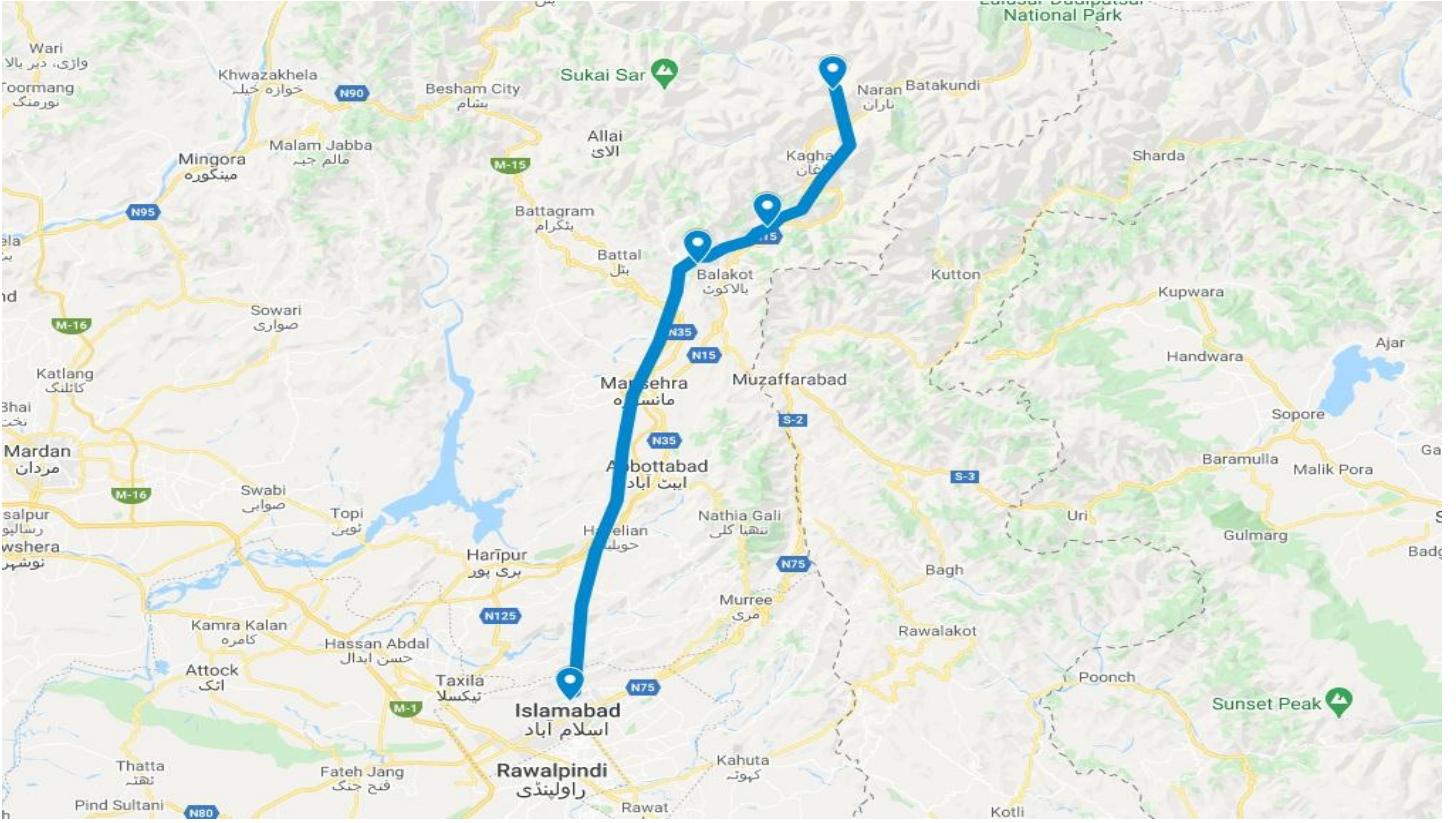

Daily Itinerary

- Day 1

Islamabad is the capital city of Pakistan, and is federally administered as part of the Islamabad Capital Territory. Islamabad is the ninth largest city in Pakistan, while the larger Islamabad–Rawalpindi metropolitan area is the country's fourth largest with a population of about 3.1 million.

Travel from Islamabad to Shogran via Kiwai. Reached shogran in evening. Overnight stay in Shogran.

- Day 2

Shogran is a hill station situated on a green plateau in the Kaghan Valley, northern Pakistan at a height of 2,362 metres (7,749 ft) above sea level. It is located in the province of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa. Shogran is located at a distance of 34 kilometres away from Balakot. Siri Paye is situated at a height of almost 9,498 feet, Siri Paye meadows is an unforgettable sight because the view from there includes a glimpse of Makra Peak, Malika Parbat, and the mountains of Kashmir.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for Siri Paye via jeep. Enjoy at siri paye. Return to shogran. Then proceed to Naran. Overnight stay at naran.

- Day 3

Naran is a medium-sized town in upper Kaghan Valley in Mansehra District of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located 119 kilometers from Mansehra city at the altitude of 2,409 meters (7,904 ft). It is located about 65 kilometer away from Babusar Top. It is a popular tourist attraction locally as well as internationally.

Lulusar Lake is a lake at 3,410 m (11,190 ft), and is the primary headwaters of the Kunhar River. It flows southwest through the entire length of Kaghan Valley, passing Jalkhand, Naran, Kaghan, Jared, Paras and Balakot until its confluence with the Jhelum River. It is located about 50 kilometres away from Naran and is accessible by any kind of vehicle. Babusar Pass or Babusar Top is located at elevation 4,173 metres or 13,691 feet. It is a mountain pass in Pakistan at the north of the 150 km long Kaghan Valley, connecting it via the Thak Nala with Chilas on the Karakoram Highway (KKH). It is the highest point in the Babusar Valley that can be easily accessed by cars. The Babusar Pass connects Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with Gilgit Baltistan.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for Sightseeing of most beautiful LULUSUR lake. After a short visit of lulusur lake proceed to Babusur top. After visiting babusur top proceed to Naran. Overnight stay at naran.

● Day 4

Jheel Saif ul Muluk is a mountainous lake located at the northern end of the Kaghan Valley, near the town of Naran in the Saiful Muluk National Park. At an elevation of 3,224 m (10,578 feet) above sea level, the lake is located above the tree line, and is one of the highest lakes in Pakistan.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for visit of legendary jheel Saif ul Muluk. After enjoying at Jheel saif ul muluk return back to naran. Visit naran bazar. Overnight stay at naran.

● Day 5

Balakot is a town in Mansehra District in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located on the right bank of the Kunhar River. It is almost at two-thirds of the length of river from its origin at Lake Dharam Sar deep in the Kaghan Valley, before it confluence with Jehlum River.

River Kunhar, is a 166 kilometres long river, located primarily in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, northern Pakistan. It is in the Indus River watershed basin.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Balakot. Short stay at River Kunhar. Overnight stay in Balakot.

● Day 6

The Faisal Mosque is a mosque located in Islamabad, Pakistan. It is the fifth-largest mosque in the world and the largest within South Asia, located on the foothills of Margalla Hills in Pakistan's capital city of Islamabad. The mosque features a contemporary design consisting of eight sides of concrete shell and is inspired by the design of a typical Bedouin tent.

The Pakistan Monument is a national monument and heritage museum located on the western Shakarparian Hills in Islamabad, Pakistan. The monument was constructed to symbolize the unity of the Pakistani people. It is dedicated to the people of Pakistan who sacrificed their "today" for a better "tomorrow". Its elevation makes the monument visible from across the Islamabad-Rawalpindi metropolitan area and is a popular tourist destination.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Short tour of Islamabad (FAISAL MOSQUE, PAKISTAN MONUMENT etc). Proceed to airport, bus terminal or train station.
