

Daily Itinerary

• Day 1

Balakot is a town in Mansehra District in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located on the right bank of the Kunhar River. It is almost at two-thirds of the length of river from its origin at Lake Dharam Sar deep in the Kaghan Valley, before it confluence with Jhelum River.

Travel from Islamabad to Balakot. Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 2

Naran is a medium-sized town in upper Kaghan Valley in Mansehra District of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located 119 kilometers from Mansehra city at the altitude of 2,409 meters (7,904 ft). It is located about 65 kilometer away from Babusar Top. It is a popular tourist attraction locally as well as internationally.

Jheel Saif ul Muluk is a mountainous lake located at the northern end of the Kaghan Valley, near the town of Naran in the Saiful Muluk National Park. At an elevation of 3,224 m (10,578 feet) above sea level, the lake is located above the tree line, and is one of the highest lakes in Pakistan.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Naran. Visit Jheel Saif ul Mulook. Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 3

Lulusar Lake is a lake at 3,410 m (11,190 ft), and is the primary headwaters of the Kunhar River. It flows southwest through the entire length of Kaghan Valley, passing Jalkhand, Naran, Kaghan, Jared, Paras and Balakot until its confluence with the Jhelum River. It is located about 50 kilometres away from Naran and is accessible by any kind of vehicle. Babusar Pass or Babusar Top is located at elevation 4,173 metres or 13,691 feet. It is a mountain pass in Pakistan at the north of the 150 km long Kaghan Valley, connecting it via the Thak Nala with Chilas on the Karakoram Highway (KKH). It is the highest point in the Babusar Valley that can be easily accessed by cars. The Babusar Pass connects Khyber Pakhtunkhwa with Gilgit Baltistan.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Short visit at Lulusar lake and Babusar top. Proceed to Gilgit. Overnight stay in hotel.

● Day 4

Skardu is a town in the region of Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan. It is the capital of Baltistan that is perched 2,438 meters above sea level in the backdrop of the great peaks of the Karakoram. Lower Kachura Lake is located in Kachura village in Skardu city at a height of 2,500 meters (8,200 ft). The lake is also known as Shangrila lake after a resort built on its bank in 1983. Upper Kachura Lake is of clear water and has a depth of 70 meters (230 ft). In summer it has a temperature of 15 °C (59 °F). In winter the surface is frozen solid. The upper Indus River flows nearby at a lower elevation.

Morning breakfast at hotel . Proceed to Skardu. After reaching you will be taken for a visit to Shangrila Lake and Upper Kachura Lake. Overnight stay in hotel.

● Day 5

The Cold Desert is a high-altitude desert located near Skardu, Gilgit-Baltistan. The desert contains large sand dunes that are sometimes covered in snow during winter. Situated at an elevation of 2,226 metres (7,303 ft) above sea level, the Cold Desert is one of the highest deserts in the world.

The Shigar Fort means The Fort on Rock is an old fort of Baltistan and Pakistan located in the town of Shigar. It was built in the 17th century by the Raja of Amacha Dynasty of Shigar.

Manthokha Waterfall is a waterfall located in Kharmang Valley, Skardu, Gilgit-Baltistan, the extreme northern region of Pakistan. This waterfall is approx 180 feet high from ground and located almost 80 kilometers away from downtown Skardu.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for Visit of Sarfaranga Cold Desert, Shigar Fort and Manthokha waterfall. Overnight stay in hotel.

● Day 6

The Deosai National Park is a high-altitude alpine plain (plateau) and national park in the Northern Pakistan region of Gilgit-Baltistan. Deosai Plains are situated at an average elevation of 4,114 meters (13,497 ft) above sea level and considered as the second highest plateaus in the world.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for full day excursion to Deosai Plains. Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 7

Satpara Lake is a natural lake near Skardu, Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan, which supplies water to Skardu Valley. It is fed by the Satpara Stream. It is situated at an elevation of 2,636 meters (8,650 ft) above sea level and is spread over an area of 2.5 km².

Manthal Buddha Rock is a large granite rock on which picture of Buddha has engraved which probably dates back to 8 century. This rock is located in Manthal village of Skardu Town, in Pakistan. Buddha Rock is one of the most important relics of Buddhism in Skardu.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for visit of beautiful Satpara Lake. Short stay at Budda Rock. Visit to Katpana Desert/Lake. Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 8

Chilas (Urdu: چلاس) is a city and is the divisional capital of Diamer District located in Gilgit-Baltistan, Pakistan, on the Indus River. It is part of the Silk Road connected by the Karakoram Highway and N-90 National Highway, which link it to Islamabad and Peshawar in the southwest, via Hazara and Malakand Divisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Leave for Chilas. Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 9

Balakot is a town in Mansehra District in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province of Pakistan. It is located on the right bank of the Kunhar River. It is almost at two-thirds of the length of river from its origin at Lake Dharam Sar deep in the Kaghan Valley, before it confluence with Jhelum River.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Balakot (4 hrs drive). Overnight stay in hotel.

• Day 10

Islamabad is the capital city of Pakistan, and is federally administered as part of the Islamabad Capital Territory. Islamabad is the ninth largest city in Pakistan, while the larger Islamabad-Rawalpindi metropolitan area is the country's fourth largest with a population of about 3.1 million.

Morning breakfast at hotel. Proceed to Islamabad. Drop off at airport, bus terminal or train station.
